We had a virtual interclub today with the eKiwanis Club of Greater Chicago. The “e” indicates that the club is internet-based. The Chicago club was the 2nd such club (chartered in 2002), and is celebrating their coming of age having just turned 18 years old. The club was formed by former Circle-Kers. They currently have 26 members and perform over 1,000 hours of service annually. That’s 2 or 3 projects per month, including such things as Feed My Starving Children, Lincoln Park community services, trash pick-ups, Christmas Caroling, and working with Ronald McDonald House. Their signature project is one where they partner with the local police to perform car-seat safety checks. The club provides new car seats for those who need them. By being “electronic,” e-clubs give their members more flexibility, lower costs, and reflect greater geographic and social diversity. It also allows more time for service! They have one meeting per month, and one board meeting every other month. They do meet in person 3-6 times per year at various restaurants, or on ZOOM during pandemics. In addition to all this, they sponsor the Clearbrook Aktion Club and the Jones College Prep High School Key Club, and run several fundraisers. Website: eKiwanis.org
