We were joined today by Tom Matya from Opportunity House. Day programs include community day services (education and skills development for about 75 people); OH University, in conjunction with Kish College provides 70 classes and can result in a certificate from Kish. OH currently helps 28 individuals with outside employment. Ideal Industries has been one of the larger employers of OH clients. Getting a paycheck really helps with self-esteem among the clients. Today is a big day for the residential program. Two new homes are coming on line, both located in Sycamore. The Rich Road facility is being closed, as it was not in a great location (busy street, no sidewalks). The total is eight homes in the DeKalb/Sycamore area, with approval for two more. The big issue is finding enough staff. With a budget of about \$8.5 million and over 100 employees, OH is one of the larger non-profits in the county. Due to the employees' dedication, OH was able to stay open throughout the pandemic. In addition to paid staff, OH relies on community volunteers to check in on clients every now and then. Two programs that OH provides (that many other similar agencies don't) are recreation and Special Olympics. Recreation can be going to a movie or Buffalo Wild Wings to watch a ball game or even trips to Chicago. This is Opportunity House's 60<sup>th</sup> year. Look for a big event in August.
