There was a change of scenery today as we met at Byer's Brewing on Lincoln Highway (that explains why you couldn't find us at Faranda's). Owner Steve Byers was our host and program. The brewery has been here for about 4 years now, and have already earned a Business of the Year from the Chamber. They have bought the Forge building on 6<sup>th</sup> Street. (If you were a fan of the Forge Root Beer – good news! Byers is now producing it!)

Steve grew up 7 miles west of Shabbona, went to school in Sycamore and college at Kish and ISU, and was a teacher at the DeKalb School District (Huntley Middle School). He and his wife Megan quit their jobs (Megan at NW medicine) to open and run the brewery. They started brewing while in college, with mixed results. Family obligations drove Megan from brewing, but Steve and his friend Todd kept at it. They

made a lot of beer (and drank a lot of beer). The experience helped them fine tune their techniques to the point where they could brew specific types of beers with a variety of flavors ("notes"). Steve eventually went to a brewing class in Colorado. A wide range of topics were covered, beyond just the actual brewing (how to design a brewery, e.g.). Various commercial brewery owners were there, and were generous with advice, recipes, etc. It's an "all ships rise" type of industry. At this point the decision to open a brewery was made. Definitely a home-made operation, as Steve designed it, and even made the benches we sat on. Cohen Barnes (current DeKalb mayor and building owner), wanting a cool business for downtown, agreed to a rent structure the Byers could afford for the brewery. Brewing tip – dirty kegs can ruin a beer, so don't skimp on a keg cleaner. Byers, as the only local brewer, is trying to become THE beer supplier for restaurants in DeKalb County and environs. They have two full-time paid employees and a couple of part-timers. A portion of proceeds from each of their beers go (or will go) to different non-profits in the area. Times have been tough financially for this community-minded business, so they would truly support your patronage! See photo on Page 3!
